
Fun facts: Did you know?

- One of the oldest olive trees is in Al-Walaja, near Bethlehem, and is over 2,000 years old, possibly as old as 5,500 years old
- Olives are planted in the Tree Season, which starts on Tree Day on 15 January and ends on Land Day on 30 March.
- Christmas is celebrated on three different days in Palestine 25 December, 6 January for Greek Orthodox Christians and 18 January for Armenian Orthodox Christians.
- Arabic is written from right to left.
- Nearly half of Palestine's land is dedicated to olive production.
